## Hearts and Minds

- In Rwanda, listeners were 1.2 times more likely than non-listeners to say husbands and wives are equal partners in a relationship.
- In Nepal, listeners were 2.7 times more likely than non-listeners to believe that women and men have equal leadership capabilities.
- In the Democratic Republic of the Congo, listeners were 3.2 times more likely than non-listeners to say girls should be encouraged to pursue their education to a high level.
- In Burkina Faso, listeners were 2.2 times more likely than non-listeners to believe a woman can use contraception and still be faithful to her partner.
- In Papua New Guinea, listeners were 2.8 times more likely than non-listeners to seek family planning services.
